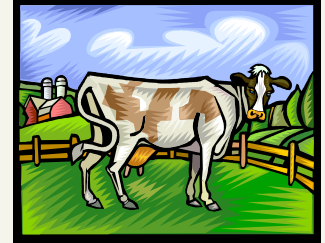

With the wheat crop looking very favorable this spring it is time to think about protecting your investment.

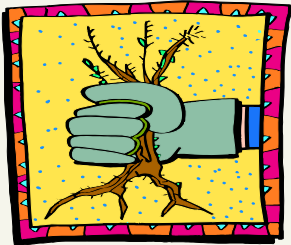
With grain prices at all time highs, the use of fungicide is now a more viable option. Fungicide will protect your wheat crop against rust, tan spot, leaf blotch, septoria

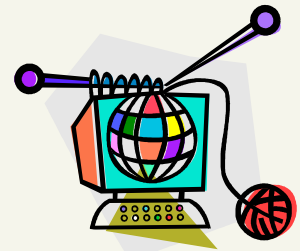

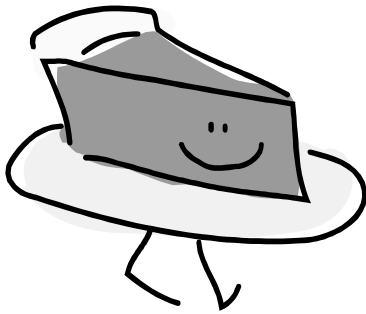
